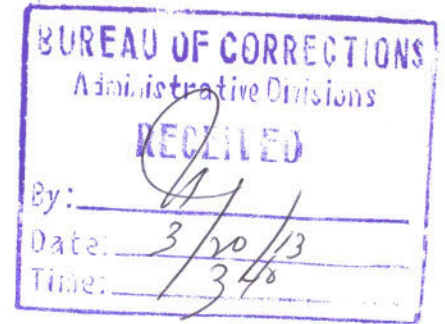

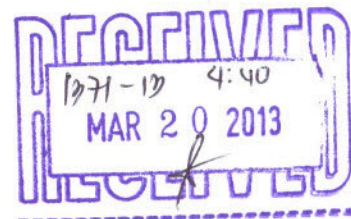
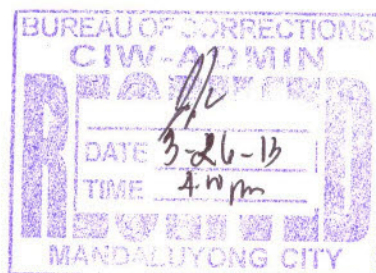

Attached is the Memorandum of Agreement between the Bureau of Corrections and Mang Kiko Catering Services Inc. regarding the Contract for Inmates' Food Provision at the Correctional Institution for Women (Mandaluyong), this Bureau, for the total contract amount equivalent to **NINETY-SEVEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED NINETY-SIX PESOS and 32/100 (P 97,396.32) per day**. Notice is hereby given to you to commence on the project immediately upon compliance with the posting of the required Performance Security as provided under Section III of the Memorandum of Agreement based on the Total Contract Price.

Your one (1) month contract shall commence effective 13 December 2012 to January 12, 2013.

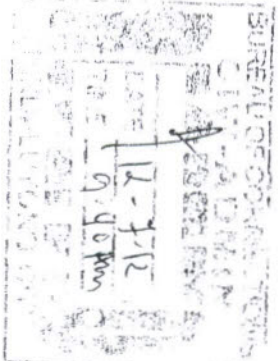
Returned to the Officer-in-Charge, Bureau of Corrections, Muntinlupa City, **hereby DISAPPROVING**, the request of Supt. IV Rachel D. Ruelo, Correctional Institute for Women, as embodied in the latter's letter dated 01 October 2012, for another extension of the contract of services of Marinold Grill Co. from 01 October 2012, until such time that the catering contract of the winning bidder is approved by this Department, it appearing that there were complaints against Marinold Grill, Co. about its unsatisfactory performance and inadequacy of food served to said inmates.

Further, in her 3<sup>rd</sup> Indorsement dated 4 October 2012, the Secretary of Justice has already instructed the BUCOR to initiate appropriate administrative action, and, if warranted, to impose other sanctions against Marinold Grill Co. for the latter's failure to take action on the said complaints despite repeated demands.

Thus, considering the apparent existence of factual merit in the aforesaid allegations against Marinold Grill Co., prudence dictates that the extension of the subject contract may prejudice the government should there be an adverse finding against Marinold later on.

However, in order not to disrupt and impair the efficient and effective delivery of service by the CIW, and considering the urgency of the situation, the CIW is hereby directed to immediately negotiate with a technically, legally, and financially capable supplier/caterer in accordance with the rules on Negotiated Procurement (Emergency cases) under Section 53.2 of the RIRR of R.A. No. 9184.

It is understood that the negotiated contract shall only be effective while the CIW is still conducting a re-bidding and shall automatically terminate when the contract, awarded by the CIW pursuant to the re-bidding, is approved by this Department. However, the negotiated contract shall not exceed three (3) months.
