SAN RAMON PRISON AND PENAL FARM, through its Bids and Awards Committee, invites interested bidders to bid for the hereunder one (1) lot with the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of Thirty million Seven hundred sixty nine thousand five hundred pesos (₱30,769,500.00). Bids received higher or lower the P50/day/capita should be automatically rejected.

The BUREAU OF CORRECTION now invites bids for Catering Services for inmates confined at the San Ramon Prison and Penal Farm.

San Ramon Prison and Penal Farm will shoulder all incidental expenses during the duration of the contract, but not limited to such as water, space for cooking facilities, and storage for perishable and non-perishable items.

The contract shall be up to **December 31, 2017** and will commence upon approval of Contract Agreement.

Bidders should have completed, within 2 (two) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.

Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulation (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise as the "Government Procurement Reform Act".

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizen/sole proprietorships, partnership, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizen or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183 and subject to Commonwealth Act 138.

Interested bidders may obtain further information from BAC Secretariat Office, San Ramon Prison and Penal Farm and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday, and 8:00am to 3:00 pm Wednesday.

A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased by interested Bidders from **November 25, 2016 to December 15, 2016** from the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents in the amount of Php25,000.00 as set by GPPB Resolution no. 04-2012. It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippines Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entry, provided that the Bidders shall pay the non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.


