

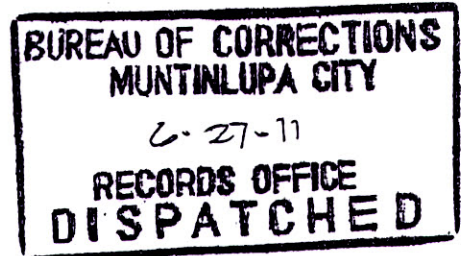

**MEMORANDUM**

SUBJ. : Cancellation of Sleep- Out Privilege for Prisoners

DATE : 22 June 2011

This has reference to the "Sleep-Out" privilege given to living-out inmates which were proven to have been abused and used as a means of going outside prison reservation without authority and with impunity. An act tantamount to escape and gross neglect.

To prevent similar occurrence, sleep-out privilege is hereby **"CANCELLED"** and all inmates granted said privilege is hereby recalled and ordered to report back to the Minimum Security Camp for proper physical headcount, otherwise they will be declared "missing".

Inmates with institutional assignments/projects may proceed to their shanty in the morning but must return and sleep inside the Minimum Security Camp for proper headcount. Similar procedure is accorded to other inmates with peculiar situation.

The OIC, Minimum Security Camp as well as the OIC, BRSS are hereby instructed to map out plans to jointly implement this instruction immediately. Submit detailed report of compliance within twenty four (24) hours.
