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6. GUIDELINES:

- 6.1 PDLs tested positive for drug use will need to undergo detoxification process at the Detox Unit at the NBP Hospital for 1 month or longer as the need arise before to undergo TC Program.
- 6.2 Evaluation
 - 6.2.1. Phase 1, after 4 months, TC clients may be promoted to head of department of TC, expeditors, and training staff in accordance to their progress and development.
 - 6.2.2. Phase 2, they shall be recommended to undergo different interventions or Reformation Programs
- 6.3 Refer to BuCor TCC Manual for other guideline.
