II. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order and presided by the BAC Chairman CCSupt. Richard W. Schwarzkopf, Jr. at 3:00 in the afternoon.

III.HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRE-BID CONFERENCE

Mr. Catindig mentioned the ABC to be bid of Php 2,500,000.00. He also emphasized that the License to Operate (LTO) and Certificate Product Registration (CPR) would be needed for post-qualification purposes.

Mr. Catindig stated that the similar contracts shall refer to manufacturer, retailer, supplier,
 distributor, trader of Medical Supply.

As to the query of one of the bidders if it they still need to submit other requirements even if they already have PhilGeps, Mr.Catindig stated that there is no need to submit legal documents if a platinum PhilGeps is already submitted. He emphasized that the request to submit legal documents would expedite the post-qualification process.

Valid and current PhilGeps Certificate of Registration and Membership in accordance with Section 8.5.2 of Revised IRR of RA 9184.

Valid and current Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) Registration for Corporation.

Valid and current Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) Registration for Sole Proprietorship and Valid and current Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) Registration for cooperative.

Valid and current Mayor's/Business Permit issued by the city of municipality where the place of business of the prospective bidder is located.

Valid and current Tax Clearance per Executive Order 398, series of 2005 as finally reviewed and approved by the BIR.

Statement of prospective bidder of all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar or not similar in nature.

Statement identifying the bidder's Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC), similar to the contract to be bid within the last two (2) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids equivalent to at least twenty-five percent 25% of the ABC.

Certificateof end-user's acceptance (EUA) or Acceptance Report or official receipt (OR) or sales invoice (SI) issued for the contract, if completed, which shall be attached to the statement.

As to the query of one of the bidders if the purchase order with combined projects aside from the drug testing kit may be accepted as a single largest completed contract. Atty. Santos stated that it will not be qualified as a single contract. Further, the bidder asked if it could be possible to use the PO if the project title is Laboratory Supplies, Mr. Catindig replied in affirmative since the laboratory supplies is the same with the medical supplies.

Mr. Catindig continued in discussing the financial requirements:

> Valid and current Audited Financial Statements, showing, among others, the prospective 1 bidder's total and current assets and liabilities, stamped "received" by the BIRwhich 2 3 should not be earlier than two (2) years from the date of bid submission. 4 Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) which must be at least equal to the ABC to 5 6 be bid, and calculated as follows: NFCC = [(Current assets minus current liabilities)] 7 (15)] minus the value of all outstanding or uncompleted portions of the projects under ongoing contracts, including awarded contracts yet to be started coinciding with the 8 contract to be bid. 9 10 In Lieu of the NFCC computation the bidder may submits a Committed Line of Credit 11 (CLC) from a Universal or Commercial Bank, it must be at least equal to ten percent 12 (10%) of the ABC to be bid. 13 As to the query of one of the bidders on the submission of documents for those who are under 14 joint venture, Mr. Catindig stated that both parties must submit legal documents and PhilGeps 15 Certificate and that either party must submit the rest of the requirements. 16 In case the joint venture is not yet in existence, the submission of a valid JVA shall be 17 within ten (10) calendar days from receipt by the bidder of the notice from the BAC that 18 the bidder is the Lowest Calculated Bid. 19 20 > The Bidder shall have the option to post Bid Securing Declaration. Bid Securing 21 Declaration must be duly notarized in accordance with the provisions of 2004 Rules on 22 Notarial Practice or any form of Bid Security. 23 24 > Cash or cashier's/manager's check issued by a Universal or Commercial Bank at least 25 2% of the ABC. 26 27 > Bank draft/guarantee or irrevocable letter of credit issued by a Universal or Commercial 28 Bank: Provided, however, that it shall be confirmed or authenticated by a Universal or 29 Commercial Bank, if issued by a Foreign Bank. 30 31 > Surety bond callable upon demand issued by a surety or insurance company duly 32 certified by the Insurance Commission as authorized to issue such security at least 5% of 33 the ABC. And to include the 14 grounds. 34 35 Duly Conformed Schedule of Requirements. 36 37 Duly Conformed Technical specification. 38 39 > Duly notarized Omnibus Sworn Statement. It must be supported by a Proof of Authority 40 of the designated representative/s. 41 42 > Duly notarized Special Power of Attorney -For sole proprietorship if owner opts to 43 designate a representative/s; 44 45 > Duly notarized Secretary's Certificate evidencing the authority of the designated 46 representative/s, issued by the corporation, cooperative or the members of the joint 47

venture;

48 49 Provided that in the case of unincorporated joint venture, each member shall submit a separate Duly notarized Special Power of Attorney and/or Duly Notarized Secretary's Certificate evidencing the authority of the designated representative/s.

Packaging and sealing of documents. It must be properly sealed and properly labeled. Each Bidder shall submit the following in *one* (1) big envelope duly labelled containing two sets of envelopes: First envelope must contain four (4) copies of Eligibility and Technical Documents duly marked as "Original Technical Component", "Copy No.1", "Copy No.2" and "Copy No.3" Second envelope must contain four (4) copies of Financial Bid Form duly marked as "Original Financial Component", "Copy No.1", "Copy No.2" and "Copy No.3"

12 Atty. Santos suggested to the prospective bidders to submit eligibility requirements with tabbing.

- 13 Mr. Catindig stated to read ITB clause 20.4 for the labeling of envelope.
- 14 Mr. Catindig stated that the deadline for submission of bids is on July 08, 2019-3:00pm. He
- emphasized that late submission will not be accepted. He pointed out that the bid documents may
- 16 be submitted to the BAC Sec as early as Friday to be safe.
- 17 Mr. Catindig stated that the Latest Income and Business Tax Return filed thru Electronic Filing
- and Payment System (EFPS) 6 months before filing duly validated with the tax payments made
- 19 thereon also refers to the Value Added tax be submitted upon receiving a notice that the bidders
- 20 have been declared as the lowest calculated bid.
- 21 Mr. Catindig stated other requirements including License to Operate (LTO), Certificate of
- 22 Product Registration (CPR)
- 23 He emphasized that the Schedule of requirements and Delivery shall commence within thirty
- 24 (30) calendar days after the receipt of Notice to Proceed (NTP) and Purchase Order (P.O.)or
- 25 Contract Agreement.
- 26 A technical specification was discussed.
- 27 As to the guery of one of the bidders if 60 ml bottle for urine collection is the required
- 28 specifications. Mr. Catindig stated that since it is not specified on the technical specification they
- 29 could probably used it.
- 30 He further discusses the bidding forms and other requirements including the valid ID that shall
- 31 be presented during notarization.
- 32 He reminded the bidders to include Supplemental Bid Bulletins issued by the BAC.
- 33 He also presented the Schedule of prices and reminded the bidders to be mindful of the
- 34 signatures.
- As to the query of one of the bidders if there will be product evaluation, Mr. Catindig stated that
- 36 bidders must be compliant to the technical specifications.
