MINUTES OF THE PRE-BID CONFERENCE FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF VARIOUS MEDICINE FOR NBP AND CIW 2019 PhP 111,994,611.81

The pre-bid conference for Medicine held at <u>BAC Conference Room</u> was called to order at around 9:00A.M. of 30 April 2019, and was presided over by the BAC Chairperson, CTCSUPT. MA. LOURDES M. RAZON.

II. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order and presided by Dr. Tamayo at 9:00 in the morning.

III. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

IV. HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRE-BID CONFERENCE

- CTCSupt. Razon aknowledged the presence of the prospective bidders and established that there is quorum. Further, she encouraged the bidders to raise questions if there is any clarification on the bidding documents.
- Mr. Alexis Catindig greeted and welcomed the suppliers who joined the pre-bid conference. Further, he mentioned the Approved Budget for Contract (ABC) to be bid for the whole project.

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- He also stated that the Delivery of the Goods is required within 30 days from the receipt of Notice to Proceed (NTP) and Contract Agreement. Bidders should have completed, within the last two (2) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project equivalent to at least twenty-five (25%) percent of the ABC to be bid.
- He further stated that the bidding documents, upon payment of a non-refundable fee for the bidding documents pursuant to the latest guidelines issued by the GPPB in the amount of one tenth of one percent of the total ABC to be bid.
- He presented the Class A documents/eligibility documents to be submitted;
 - ✓ Valid and Current PhilGeps Certificate of Registration and membership in accordance with section 8.5.2 of the revised IRR of 9184 Platinum membership. Suggested to still submit the legal and financial documents for post qualification purposes and to include also the Sec registration for corporation and for sole proprietorship the DTI certification of registration.
 - ✓ Legal Documents; valid and current SEC registration for corporation, valid and current DTI certificate of registration for sole proprietorship, valid and current development cooperative authority, valid and current mayor's business permit, in case business permit is already expired they still can submit together with the proof of renewal provided that the mayor's permit will be submitted on post qualification period.
 - ✓ Technical documents; statement of prospective bidders of all its ongoing government and private contracts included awarded but not yet started if any whether similar or not similar in nature.
 - ✓ Statement identifying the single largest contract similar to the contract to be bid within the last four years from the date of submission and receipt of bids equivalent to at least 50% of the ABC per lot. With supporting documents of Certificate of enduser's acceptance (EUA) or Acceptance Report or official receipt (OR) or collection receipt (CR) or sales invoice (SI).
- Mr. Sescar added that Charge Invoice will only be accepted if supported with Collection Receipt.
- As to the query of the bidder if which invoice is needed to be submitted as support to their document since their deliveries are on a staggered basis, Mr. Catindig encouraged submission of all P.Os. and the invoice upon completion of their delivery. One of the bidders further asked if it is possible to submit the last invoice and the last collection receipt, Mr. Catindig stated that if there are problems on the invoice they could submit the EUA or proof of the completed project.
 - √ Financial documents; valid and current audited financial statements (FS) showing among others the prospective bidder

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total current assets and liabilities stamped received by the BIR or its duly authorized institutions, for the preceding calendar year, which should not be earlier than two (2) years from the bid submission.

As to the query of the bidder on what to submit if their 2018 FS was not yet released by the BIR, Mr. Catindig stated that they can submit their 2016 to 2017 FS provided that during post-qualification period they have already their updated FS.

- ✓ NFCC which must be at least equal to the ABC to be bid and calculated as follows; current assets minus current liabilities multiply by 15 plus the value of all outstanding or uncompleted portion of the project under ongoing contract including contract awarded but not yet started.
- ✓ The values of the bidder's current assets and current liabilities shall be based on the latest Audited Financial Statements submitted to the BIR, through its Electronic Filing and Payment System (EFPS). In Lieu of NFCC the bidder may submit a committed line of credit from a universal or commercial bank it must be equal to ten percent of the ABC to be bid.
- He suggested that the arrangement of the documents as discussed will be the same on what will be submitted to speed up the reading of bids.
 - ✓ Bid Security; the bidder shall have the option to post bid securing declaration it must be duly notarized in accordance with the provision of 2004 rules for notarial practice. Other forms; Cash, Cashier/Managers check issued by the universal bank, bank draft guarantee or irrevocable line of credit issued by a universal or commercial bank at least two percent of the ABC to be bid, Surety bond callable upon demand issued by a surety or insurance company duly certified by the insurance commission as authorized to issue such surety at least five percent of the ABC to include 14 grounds.
 - ✓ Duly conformed schedule of requirement.
 - ✓ Duly conformed technical specification.
 - Duly notarized omnibus sworn statement. It must be by a proof of authority of the designated representative for the purpose of this bidding. SPA for sole proprietorship, Secretary Certificate for Corporation, or a combination if Joint Venture.
 - ✓ Packaging and sealing of documents. Each Bidder shall submit the following in one (1) big envelope duly labelled containing two sets of envelopes: First envelope must contain four (4) copies of Eligibility and Technical Documents duly marked as "Copy No.1", "Copy No.2", "Copy No.3" and "Copy No.4" Second envelope

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- As to the query of the bidder if there is color coding on the envelopes that needs to be submitted, Mr. Catindig stated that there is no need for color in order to ease difficulty in the bidding process.
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 CSSupt. Bravo emphasized the importance of labelling the envelopes for the eligibility requirements and financial documents submitted.

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As to the query of the bidder if the three copies are not original copy of the first envelope, Mr. Catindig stated that the three copies are only photo copies of the original documents and that the signatures affixed on it are original.

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He mentioned that the opening of bids will be on May 14, 2019 at 9:00AM and late submission will not be accepted.

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 Schedule of requirements; thirty calendar days' delivery period, from the issuance of NTP.

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Mr. Catindig presented the Technical Specifications and bidding forms.

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Mr. Catindig emphasized that bidders who have loose packaging may not join since they would never comply with the required specifications.

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The BAC Members requested for a five minutes recess.

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V. QUERIES FROM INTERESTED BIDDERS

Item #4 (Acetylcisteine 600 mg)

Relative to the statement of the the dosage form for item #4 is for tablet while sachet is for 100 to 200mg, CCSupt. Razon stated that amendments from sachet to milligrams will be reflected in the supplemental bid bulletin. Another bidder stated that individualy packed is available on the market that is and some are on its canister form. And there are also on its capsule preparation.

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Item #12 (Alpha- lipoic Acid 920 mg)

40 41 42 As to the comment that alpa lipoic acid is just one of the ingredients of 920mg and that there are still other ingredients that was not reflected which is the same problem encountered previous year, CCSupt. Razon stated that it will be supplemented.

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Items #18 & 19

46 47 Quantity was changed to 1500 and will be subject for supplemental bid bulletin.

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Item #20 & 21

50 51 Was removed and according to CSSupt. Tamayo they are the same

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Item #33

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 As to the query if there is possibility to convert the specification into capsule form, Dr. Tamayo stated that he needs to consult the end user.

ltem #82

 Another query if the specification can be converted to capsule preparation instead of tablet.

Item 84

As to the query if it is the same with citicholine sodium 500mg, Mr. Catindig stated that the corrections it is noted.

Item #99:

 so I notice that the preparation is very specific to one product can we have a range like 800 to 900 nalang? Doc t: hindi pwede kasi pag range ng gram my Malaki may maliit isan price lang kasi pag Malaki ang gram mas mahal

Item 100

 As to the requirement of the hospital for HMB, Dr. Tamayo stated that it is intended for cancer patients.

Item 148

As to the comment that the there is missing in the specifications, Dr. Tamayo stated that the end-users will be asked about it.

Item 152

As to the query if 60 mg ferrous sulfate may be replaced with folic acid 250, Dr. Razon replied that it is not acceptable.

Item 171

Dr. Razon noted corrections that it should be 300mg

Item 193

As to the query if the volume is 10ml or 3ml, Dr. Tamayo stated that it would be difficult to use 3ml since there will be lots of used bottles and that there is difficulty in storage. However, Dr. Tamayo stated that it can be amended if there will no bids received.

Item 194

As to the query on whether the specifications can be 3.64mg/ml by 100mg/ml, Dr. Tamayo stated that the specs mentioned is lower than the required.

Item 226

As to the query if ingredients is specifically milk, Dr. Razon replied in affirmative.

Mr. Catindig stated that there are request from bidders to amend the schedule of prices. He emphasized that there is a need to change the schedule of prices.

As to the query of a bidder if they can suggest different dosage for items that require tablets such as proposing for capsule form, Dr. Tamayo stated that it is the milligrams that it important. He emphasized that they must be specific and that ampule is more difficult because there is no sealing once it was opened.

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- Item 176 Dr. Tamayo stated that it is capsule. Dr. Razon requested to specify salt.
- Item 202:

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- Dr. Razon stated it is MR and not SR.
- As to the issue on VAT exemption, Mr. Catindig stated that it is the way it was posted.
