Resolution No. 02 s. 2019

WHEREAS, the PMT has convened to deliberate the Office Performance Commitment Review (OPCR) - Success Indicators that were proposed and agreed by the representatives from the different Operating Prison and Penal Farms and Directorates during the seminar entitled Evaluation and Enhancement Of BuCor Success Indicators held last May 2-3, 2019 at the DAP, Tagaytay City.

WHEREAS, after the successful meetings and final deliberations held last May 29, 30 and June 20, 2019 and with the concurrence of the different heads of delivery units , the PMT has unanimously agreed on the success indicators with standard rating scale (Annex A), for the purpose of evaluations and assessments of performances of each delivery units for the rating period January to June and July to December 2019.

WHEREAS, the PMT likewise agreed that for the purpose of evaluation and validation of performances, the number of delivery units will be based on the BuCor's Interim Organizational Structure on the implementation of RA 10575 pursuant to Special Order No. 410 s.. 2018 dated 25 July 2018.

WHEREAS, the PMT also agreed on the following guidelines in determining the final rating and ranking of the delivery units;

For the Directorates:

- The percentage weight allocation in performance rating shall be 70% for the core functions while 30% for the support functions. The combined score of the core and support functions will be the final score of the office.
- The total average score of the line divisions will be the final rating of each Directorates.

For the OPPFs:

 The success indicators will be standard to all the OPPFs, their success indicators will be distributed as follows;
