3.1. TERMS

Med. Tech. Aide/technician	• One who assists Med. Tech. on errands.
Blood Typing	 A blood examination to determine patient's blood Serotype.
Cross Matching	• An examination done to determine compatibility between donor and recipient. This is done prior to blood transfusion.
Pathologist	• A physician who interprets and diagnoses the changes caused by disease in tissues and body fluids.
Medical Technologist	• An allied health professional that analyses and tests body fluids and tissues.
Histopathology	• Refers to the microscopic examination of tissue in order to study the manifestations of disease.
