

V. Opening of Bids

The following bidders were present:

1. POWER KING INDUSTRIES CORP.,
2. GMIC
3. AMS
4. PRINCE MOTOR CORP.,
5. AREZA MOTORS
6. SWIFT GLOBAL

8. MACHSOURCE

Upon motion of CTCSUPT JOHN PAUL SANTOS duly seconded by CSUPT VIRGINIA MANGAWIT, the prebid of Light and Heavy Equipment was formally adopted.

CTCSUPT JOHN PAUL SANTOS instructed CTO2 Alexis Catindig to discuss the eligibilities or required documents to be submitted by the bidders.

CTO2 Catindig inform the bidders that questions will be entertained after his discussion. He said that for this bidding, the 6th Edition of Philippine Bidding Documents will be used. For the project, the funding source is INCOME and the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is P78,000,000.00. It includes one (1) lot only.

CTO2 Catindig said that the delivery of goods is required within ninety (90) calendar days from the date of issuance of Notice to Proceed.

CTO2 Catindig said one of the requirements is that bidders should have completed within the last two (2) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids a contract similar to the project equivalent to at least fifty (50) % of the (ABC).

CTO2 Catindig proceeded with the discussion of the checklist which includes the following:

- a) Legal Documents
 - PhilGeps Registration (Platinum Membership)
 - Registration Certification
 - SEC for Corporation
 - DTI for Sole Proprietorship
 - Mayor's Business Permit
 - Tax Clearance
- b) Technical Documents
 - Statement of Prospective Bidders or On-going Contracts
 - Statement of Bidders Single Largest Completed Contracts (SLCC)
 - Original Copy of Bid Security
 - Schedule of Requirements
 - Technical Specifications

- 100 - Original duly signed and notarized Omnibus Sworn Statement
- 101 - Authority of Signatory, unless Sole Proprietorship
- 102 - Secretary Certificate
- 103 - Joint Venture Agreement (JVA)
- 104 - Audited Financial Statements
- 105 - Prospective bidders NFCC or a committed line of credit from the universal commercial bank
- 106 of at least equal to ten (10) % of the ABC
- 107 - Financial Bid Form
- 108 - Duly accomplished schedule of prices

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112 After discussing the requirements needed, CTCSUPT JOHN PAUL SANTOS said that they may
113 proceed to the question and answer portion.
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115 CTO2 Catindig informed the bidders that Opening is scheduled on 16 March 2021 at 0900H. All
116 envelopes must be submitted not later than the said schedule.
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119 The first question is if it is possible that in SLCC, 25% may be considered.
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121 CTO2 Catindig answered that 50% of the ABC is required because the project includes non-
122 expandable supplies.
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125 The second question from the bidder is in case of the joint venture, should the joining parties submit
126 all the requirements in the checklist.
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128 CTINSP RIC A ROCACURBA asked CTO2 Catindig to read the provision about joint venture. He
129 said that if joint venture was formed for the project, parties involved shall submit their statement of
130 joint venture within ten (10) calendar days from the issuance of Notice of Appeal with respect to the
131 winning bidder. And as to the question, all documents in the checklist must be submitted by both
132 the parties.
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135 The third question from the bidders is how many percent of retention is needed in the BID Securing
136 Declaration.
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139 CTINSP RIC A ROCACURBA answered that there is no provision about retention in Bid Security.
140 CTO2 Catindig said that Bid Security includes a notarized document stating conditions to follow
141 during the bidding.
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144 The next question is if contracts for motor vehicle be considered in the SLCC.
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146 CTINSP RIC A ROCACURBA said that if the title of the project encompasses light and heavy
147 equipment and the contract amounts to at least P39,000,000.00, bidder is qualified.
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150 The next question is a follow up for the joint venture. In case of the duly signed copies of the JVA,
151 are photocopies allowed.
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154 CTO2 Catindig said that for JVA, all documents must be original and notarized.
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.56 The next question is a clarification about the envelopes to be submitted. In terms of reproduction,
157 shall all the signed and notarized document be originals or they can just reproduce it.
158

159 CTO2 Catindig said that bidders are required to submit one (1) mother envelope which includes
160 two (2) envelopes. One (1) for technical specifications and one (1) for financial documents. The
161 winning bidder is the one required to reproduce the copy. He also informed the bidders to read the
162 instructions to bidders based on RA 9184.
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165 CTINSP RIC A ROCACURBA informed the bidders that after the meeting, other queries shall be
166 put into writing, two (2) days from this date and BAC will answer through Supplemental Bid Bulletin.
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169 The last question asked is if the bidder is not compliance with one of the Technical Specifications,
170 can he still be qualified upon compliance.
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172 CTCSUPT JOHN PAUL SANTOS said that bidders shall complete all the requirements. Non-
173 compliance is subject for disqualification.
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178 VI. ADJOURNMENT:

179 As there were no other matters to discuss, adjournment of the Prebid of Light and Heavy Equipment
180 was motioned by CTCSUPT JOHN PAUL SANTOS unanimously seconded by all the members.
181 The meeting was adjourned at 1043H.
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
