II. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order and presided by the BAC Chairman CTCSupt. Ma. Lourdes M. Razon, MD at 1:27 in the afternoon.

III. HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRE-BID CONFERENCE

Mr. Catindig acknowledges the attendance of bidders on the pre-bid conference. He emphasized that it was the remaining lot during the previous bidding with an ABC of Twenty Seven Million Three Hundred Twenty-Eight Thousand Pesos (Php27,328,000.00). He stressed out that the commencement date will be from September 1 to December 1 2019 which is for 122 days.



Dr. Razon stated that she encourages all bidders to raise queries and that no more queries will be entertained during the bidding. She emphasized the need for bidders to ask questions particularly on technical specifications.

Mr. Catindig stated that the bidders can also asked questions to the BAC secretariat while preparing their bidding documents. He also added that there is criterion that the bidders must pass during the checking of the eligibility requirements needed and that they must also pass the post qualification process before the BAC can declare a winning bidder.

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Mr. Catindig stated the need for a statement identifying the bidder's Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC), similar to the contract to be bid within the last four (4) years from the date of submission and receipt of a single contract that is similar to this Project, equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC per lot.

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Mr. Catindig stated that all the changes will be included in the supplemental bid bulletin and that the cost of bidding documents is Twenty Five Thousand Pesos (Php 25,000.00). He reiterated the schedule of bid opening on August 22, 2019.

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He pointed out that the eligibility documents are composed of legal, technical and financial documents. Further, he stressed out that he will commence in discussing the required legal documents.

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He also emphasized the categories of the eligibility documents as follows:

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26 27 > Valid and current PhilGeps Certificate of Registration and Membership in accordance with Section 8.5.2 of Revised IRR of RA 9184. He emphasized that the submission of all the eligibility requirements is being encouraged and that the non-submission will not be a ground for disqualification.

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52 53 Valid and current Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) Registration for Corporation or:

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Valid and current Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) Registration for Sole Proprietorship or: Valid and current Cooperative Development Authority (CDA)

Registration for cooperative.

Valid and current Mayor's/Business Permit issued by the city of municipality where the place of business of the prospective bidder is located.

Valid and current Tax Clearance per Executive Order 398, series of 2005 as finally reviewed and approved by the BIR.

Statement of prospective bidder of all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid. . He stressed out the need to include even the Notices of Award which needs no required supporting documents.

> Statement identifying the bidder's Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC), similar to the contract to be bid within the last four (4) years from the date of submission and receipt of a single contract that is similar to this Project, equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC per lot.

Certificate of end user's acceptance (EUA) or Acceptance Report or official receipt (OR) or sales invoice (SI) issued for the contract, if completed, which shall be attached to the statement.

He emphasized that collection receipt is not accepted.

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Valid and current Audited Financial Statements, showing, among others, the prospective bidder's total current assets and liabilities, stamped "received" by the BIR or its duly accredited and authorized institutions, for the preceding calendar year, which should not be earlier than two (2) years from the date of bid submission.

Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) which must be at least equal to the ABC to be bid, and calculated as follows: NFCC = [(Current assets minus current liabilities) (15)] minus the value of all outstanding or uncompleted portions of the projects under ongoing contracts, including awarded contracts yet to be started coinciding with the contract to be bid. Where: The values of the bidder's current assets and current liabilities shall be based on the latest Audited Financial Statements submitted to the BIR, through its Electronic Filing and Payment System (EFPS).

In Lieu of the NFCC, computation the bidder may submits a Committed Line of Credit (CLC) from a Universal or Commercial Bank; it must be at least equal to ten percent (10%) of the ABC to be bid in accordance with Sec 23.4.1.5 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184.

The Bidder shall have the option to post Bid Securing Declaration. Bid Securing Declaration must be duly notarized in accordance with the provisions of 2004 Rules on Notarial Practice or any form of Bid Security.

Mr. Catindig stated that the whole bidding documents including the bidding forms can be downloaded in the website.

He stated that the bidders may submit bid security which is commonly submitted since it only needs to be notarized. Further, he proceeded in discussing the other requirements:

- Cash or cashier/manager's check issued by a Universal or Commercial Bank.
- Bank draft/guarantee or irrevocable letter of credit issued by a Universal or Commercial Bank; provided however, that it shall be confirmed or authenticated by a Universal or Commercial Bank if issued by a foreign bank at least 2% of the ABC to be bid.
- Surety bond callable upon demand issued by a surety or insurance company duly certified by the insurance commission as authorized to issue such security at least five percent (5%) of the ABC. It must specify the additional grounds for forfeiture of bid security.
- Duly Conformed Schedule of Requirements
- Duly Conformed Technical specification
- Duly notarized Omnibus Sworn Statement. It must be supported by a Proof of Authority of the designated representative/s for purposes of this bidding.
- Duly notarized Special Power of Attorney –For sole proprietorship if owner opts to designate a representative/s; Duly Notarized Secretary's Certificate evidencing the authority of the designated representative/s, issued by the corporation, cooperative or the members of the joint venture;
- similar contracts shall refer to Food Subsistence such as but not limited to delivery or preparation, whether processed or in its original form, of food or edible materials for human consumption or those engaged in food business or food supply chain as defined in Food safety Act of 2013





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> Packaging and sealing of documents were presented as follows; Each Bidder shall submit the following in one (1) big envelope duly labelled containing two sets of envelopes: First envelope must contain four (4) copies of Eligibility and Technical Documents duly marked as "Copy No.1", "Copy No.2", "Copy No.3" and "Copy No.4" Second envelope must contain four (4) copies of Financial Bid Form duly marked as "Copy No.1", "Copy No.2", "Copy No.3" and "Copy No.4".

Mr. Catindia emphasized that the second envelope will only be opened provided that the bidder had passed the eligibility documents

He presented the schedule of requirements and emphasized the need to affix conformity by signing the required form.

He also presented the technical specification and emphasized the need to indicate compliance or non-compliance.

He also emphasized that during the actual implementation of the contract, the winning bidder may be allowed to use the Kitchen inside the respective camps upon written request to the Director General and upon approval of the same.

He also mentioned that the PDL food helpers may be hired by the winning bidder upon request and approval by the Director General or his authorized representative. Further, he stressed that those PDL who shall be properly selected must be properly secured with medical certificate as well as issuance of corresponding order. He added that any violations committed by PDLs on prison rules and regulations may result in revocation of issued order. Further, he also encouraged the bidders to read on the technical specifications

As to the guery of the bidder if on the cost of kitchen rental, Mrs. Sumaway replied that the rental is around twenty thousand pesos.

As to the query of the bidder if they are going to shoulder the expenses on the electricity and water, Mr. Catindig stated that all expenses including the kitchen rental shall be borne by the bidder.

As to the query of another bidder if PDLs have on their own utensils. Ms sumaway replied in affirmative and stated that PDLs bring their utensils during meal time.

As to the query of the bidder if the lunch will be served on a buffet style, Ms. Sumaway stated that the facility has a counter table with the container of food for Christians and Muslims. She emphasized that the kitchen helpers will served their food with the right measurement.

As to the query on how the food is being served to PDL, Ms Sumaway stated that a kitchen helper has a cup to measure the rice and viand. She pointed out that chicken viands are commonly cut into 100 grams per piece.
