<p>Clarifications on' Item No. 8 of Sec. I. Invitation to Bid, and Clause 16.1 of Sec. III-Bid Data Sheet relative to the Submission of at least three (3) acceptable forms of bid security that bidders may choose from BDS 16.1, which shall include Bid Securing Declaration.</p>	<p>Upon query with the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB), it is emphasized that under Sec. 56.3 of the R.A 12009, the Procuring Entity is required to indicate at least three (3) acceptable forms of bid security which shall include the Bid Securing Declaration (BSD).</p> <p>However, the bidder is required to submit only one (1) form of bid security, not multiple.</p> <p>Thus, the bidder may choose either:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bid Securing Declaration; or • Any one (1) of the other acceptable forms indicated in the Bidding Documents. <p>Submission of both BSD and another form is not required.</p> <p>This rule likewise applies to infrastructure projects, including Design and Build, unless otherwise specifically provided in the Bidding Documents consistent with the law.</p> <p>Therefore, all prospective bidders must submit One (1) form of bid security and may choose from the forms of bid security either:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bid Securing Declaration; and • Any one (1) of the other acceptable forms indicated in the Bidding Documents.
